- 2. What reason is given for the command of 4:25?
- 3. Why should the reason given in 4:25 motivate us to obey?
- 4. What are some ways we can sin in our anger? What are some ways we can be angry and not sin?
- 5. Whether the anger is sinful or not, what does 4:27 tells us to do with it?
- 6. What opportunity does our anger present for Satan?
- 7. In addition to not stealing, what is the thief to do?

Application Questions

- 1. How can we connect this passage to everything that has been said in Ephesians up until this point?
- 2. Think through and explain how each of these negative commands destroy harmony and unity, and how each of the positive commands build up harmony and unity.
- 3. In light of what this passage teaches, is there any action you need to take or sin you need to repent of? Explain.
