- 4. Use Bible study tools or ask someone to help you look up other passages regarding speech and the tongue (especially Proverbs). What do these passages tell us about the power of the tongue and the importance of words?
- 5. What three principles does 4:29 give us concerning our speech?
- 6. Why is what you say as important as how you say it? (see Prov. 10:19; 15:1; 25:11)
- 7. If our speech is going to be corrected, what needs to be dealt with first? (see Luke 6:45; James 1:26; Ps. 19:14; Prov. 15:28; 18:14; Matt. 12:25; 15:18-19)

- 1. Have you thought much about how great a privilege, power, and responsibility it is to be able to speak?
- 2. How can we encourage ourselves and each other to pay closer attention to what the Bible says about our speech?
- 3. What are some prayers we can begin praying *today* that will help us cleanse our hearts and our speech (see Ps. 19:14; Ps. 141:3; Col. 4:6)
