Ephesians 5:8-14

1. What were some of the characteristics of those who are in “darkness” (see Rom 13:11-12; Eph 4:17-19; Tit 3:3; 1 Thess 5:6-7)
2. What characterizes those who are light in the Lord (see 5:9)?
3. What does 5:8 mean when it says you *are* light *in* the Lord?
4. What does 5:10 teach us regarding our effort as children of light?
5. What does 5:10 say should be the constant behavior and trajectory of those who walk in the light?
6. Why is it not enough to obey 5:11 and ignore 5:10?
7. What will happen when Christians are faithful to understand God’s will, obey it, and take no part in the deeds of darkness?

Application Questions

1. Why is it important to not try and find a happy medium, and just be comfortable in our Christian lives as time passes?
2. How can we encourage others to avoid the myth of neutrality, and actively seek to know God through His Word, and walk as children of the Light?
3. How can we pray for SNCCC in light of what this passage teaches? (see Luke 13:24; John 12:35-36; 1 Peter 2:9-12; 1 John 1:5-7)
