1. 1:27 exhorts us to live lives worthy of the gospel.
 - a. What two expectations are listed at the end of verse 27?

 - b. How is this related to the theme of 2:1-4?

 - c. What does 1:29 say has been granted to the Philippians?

 - d. How could 1:29 be applied to us today?

2. 2:1 states the case for what is desired in 2:2-4.
 - a. To what 4 benefits does appeal the author?

 - b. What do they all have in common?

 - c. What does the urgency of 2:1 say about the urgency of the plea?

3. The main thought in 2:2 is being of the same mind.
 - a. In your own words, how would you describe that?

 - b. How would you explain it to others?

 - c. If we are to be of the same mind, whose mind are we to pattern ours after? (see 1 Cor 2:15-16; 2 Cor 10:5-6)

4. 2:3-4 further expresses the thought in 2:2.
 - a. What does 2:3-4 teach us about what it means to be of the same mind?

 - b. What are the internal (attitudes) listed in 2:3?

 - c. What are the external (actions) listed in 2:4?

5. The gravity of what is called for here is hard to miss.
 - a. In what ways will you promote unity at SNCCC?

 - b. How can we better hold each other accountable in a way that preserves unity?
