## The Christian's Warfare: Warfare Prayer Ephesians 6:18-20 Study Questions

- 1. The "scope" of our prayers is all prayers and supplications.
  - a. How does understanding the scope of our prayers encourage us to pray for anything at all times?
  - b. If we feel hesitant to pray, or discover the content of our prayers tend to be self-focused or focused too much on earthly things, what can we do to change that?
  - c. What common acronym as a model of prayer was given in the message?
- 2. The "manner" of prayer is to "keep alert with *all* perseverance."
  - a. In light of what Jesus says about this (Lk 21:34-36; Mk 13:33-37; 14:38), what does it mean to be watchful?
  - b. How does watchfulness help our prayers (1 Pet 4:7)?
  - c. How can we help each other in our tendency to drift (Heb 3:12-13)?
- 3. The "scope" is to make prayer and supplication for *all* the saints.
  - a. How can we extend our prayers beyond the Christians in our own church?
  - b. What are some model prayers we can pray for each other and for all the saints (see Col 1:9-11; Eph 1:15 -20; Phil 1:9-11)?
  - c. What does Paul ask for in 6:19-20?
